## Stellar keynote speakers, VIPs, guests & program confirmed for 8<sup>th</sup> World Chinese Economic Summit

In addition, **The Hon Dato' Sri Liow Tiong Lai**, Minister of Transport of Malaysia, **The Hon Dato Mah Siew Keong**, Prime Minister's Department Malaysia, **Ambassador Delia Albert**, former Foreign Secretary of the Philippines will lead a thought provoking Summit program and array of speakers.

Commenting on the upcoming Summit, Tan Sri Dato' Dr Michael Yeoh said "2016 marks the 8<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the WCES that was created by ASLI to enhance connectivity and business linkages between China and Southeast Asia and China and Europe in line with the Chinese leadership's Belt and Road initiatives.

"The WCES also promotes global and regional dialogue on the emergence and role of China as the world's 2nd largest economy. It also brings together the global Chinese diaspora and promotes entrepreneurship and innovation through business networking and sharing of knowledge and best practices".

Over the past 7 years, the WCES has been held in Malaysia, China, Australia and Britain and is an internationally recognised high level event and platform for business, trade facilitation and investment – and for facilitating friendships and connections with dynamic individuals and entrepreneurs attending the Summit during the social and networking activities.

The historic 8th Summit will be held in Malacca Malaysia November 16 – 17 with over 300 delegates expected to attend from around the globe to participate in a program of international speakers and China experts of the highest calibre providing visionary keynotes, insightful panel discussions and roundtables.

Commenting further on the program, Tan Sri Dato' Dr Michael Yeoh said anchored by high level keynote sessions and closely tied to other key components of the Summit, the program is structured around a series of streams and themes including –

Young Entrepreneurs Family Businesses

Innovation Education & Training

Tan Sri Dato' Dr Michael Yeoh is confident the 2016 WCES will be recognised as a major landmark event as thought leaders, policy-makers and business leaders from China, Southeast Asia and Europe come together to discuss the prominence of China's economic rise and its impact and benefit on the rest of the world.

"A key outcome of the Summit will be the reaffirmation of the importance and crucial role of the Chinese diaspora in facilitating commercial opportunities and engagement whilst providing a platform for greater understanding, awareness, insight and appreciation of Chinese culture", concluded Tan Sri Dato' Dr Michael Yeoh.
